



ENTRANCE PERMIT APPLICATION

I _____ hereby make application for the construction of an entrance from my property described as follows:

I hereby agree to supply and install at my own expense, a culvert as requested by the Municipality. Length and Diameter will be determined at the onsite inspection by municipal staff.

Every person who undertakes work shall ensure that the street is at all times maintained in a condition that allows the safe passage of vehicle and pedestrian traffic.

The property owner must pay to the municipality a non-refundable application fee of (\$100.00) prior to the commencement of the entrance.

Every person who undertakes work is responsible for the full cost of remediation that will be performed by the municipality or its contractor; should damages occur to the municipal road.

Upon completion of the entrance the municipality must be notified within fifteen days in order to complete an inspection.

The applicant hereby agrees to the following terms:

- (1) The Manager of Public Works is authorized to fully restore the municipal road;**
- (2) The applicant shall be responsible for any cost of repair or clean-up of the road;**
- (3) The Treasury department is authorized to recover any applicable costs (including applicable materials and wages) by adding them to the tax roll and collecting them in the same manner as taxes. As per Section 398 of the Municipal Act, 2001.**

Entrances that do not meet the site line requirements will be required to pay for hidden entrance signs and there placement

A property plot plan and location of entrance must be drawn on the plot plan of this application. Distances from side lot lines must be on plot plan. **Entrance must be flag for inspection. (FLAGS PROVIDED)**

This permit expires one year after approval of location.

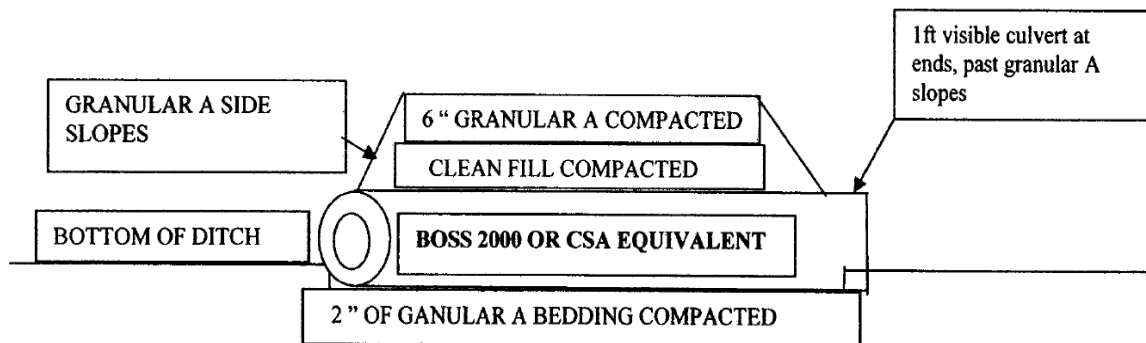

SCHEDULE A Culvert Installation Standards




INSIDE BOTTOM OF CULVERT TO BE AT SAME GRADE AS EXISTING DITCH BOTTOM OR AS
